### Typical Formats

- Conference keynote (45-75 minutes)
- Opening or closing keynote
- Leadership or executive keynote
- Keynote + facilitated Q&A
- Keynote combined with MC or panel facilitation (where appropriate)

### Working Together

Brett works closely with organisers to ensure the keynote aligns with the event's objectives and audience.

This typically includes:

- a pre-event briefing call
- alignment on audience, tone, & outcomes
- tailoring examples and emphasis where it adds value

Organisers value Brett's professionalism, preparation, and reliability, particularly when events involve multiple stakeholders or approval layers.

### What's Included

While every event is different, organisers typically receive:

- a professionally prepared keynote
- audience-appropriate content (not generic slides)
- clear communication & planning support
- flexibility on delivery format where possible

Additional sessions (workshops, panels, MC roles, extended Q&A) can be discussed as part of the event design.
